## **Representative Truitt Seeks Input From Ad Hoc Appraisal Reform Working Group**

SOUTHLAKE, TEXAS -- State Representative Vicki Truitt (R-Keller) met with invited guests and members of her ad hoc Appraisal Reform Workgroup today to discuss the history of the appraisal process as it has evolved, and to listen to current ideas under consideration targeted at improving the process.

Those attending benefitted from a discussion lead by Representative John Otto (R-Dayton), who was recently appointed by the Speaker of the House as the Chairman of the Select Committee on Property Tax Relief and Appraisal Reform.

"As a CPA and an experienced leader in the House of Representatives, Chairman Otto has some innovative ideas about how to deal with problems related to the appraisal process and how to provide responsible tax relief to those that are feeling the relentless burden of increasing taxes," said Representative Truitt.
